sector (n)		a part of an area of activity, especially of business, trade, etc.

infrastructure (n)		the basic systems and structures that a country or organisation needs in order to work properly, e.g. roads, railways, banks	
commercial (adj)		relating to schools, hospitals, office blocks and factories
