hard standing (n)		a concrete or hard surface for heavy items, e.g. vehicles	
unload (v)		to remove a load from a vehicle	
crate (n)		a large box made of wood that is used for carrying goods	
hook (n)		a curved piece of metal or plastic that you use for hanging things on	
stabiliser (n)		a piece of equipment that helps make something steady	
timber (n)		wood used for building or making things	
driver (n)		someone who drives a vehicle	
deliver (v)		to take goods to a particular place or person	
look for (v)		to try to find something or someone	
run late (phr v)		to arrive after the arranged or expected time	
lever (n)		a stick or handle on a machine or piece of equipment, that you move to operate it	
push away (v phr)		to apply force to make an object move a distance from you	
pull towards (v phr)		to apply force to make an object move nearer to you	
raise (v)		to move or lift something to a higher position	
lower (v)		to move or lift something to a lower position	
left (adv)		towards the direction or side that is on the left	

right (adv) towards the direction or side that is on the right
