out of stock (adj)			the supplier does not have the item available at the time it is ordered	
follow-up phone call (n phr)			a phone call which is made again at a later time	
three-core cable (n)			a specific type of electrical cable	
in stock (adj)			the supplier has the item available at the time it is ordered	
customer number (n)			the number given by a supplier to a customer	
order number (n)			the number given by a supplier to a customer order	
transport (n)			a system or method for carrying goods from one place to another	
place an order (v phr)			to order goods	
drill (n)			a tool used for making holes in something	
extension cable (n)			an electric wire with a plug at one end and one or more sockets at the other end	
insulating tape (n)			a type of sticky tape used for wrapping around electric wires to insulate them; it stops electricity from getting in or out
