Word			Definition	Translation
harness (n)			a set of bands used to hold someone in a place or to stop them from falling	
mask (n)			something that covers all or part of your face, to protect it	
ear protection (n)			something that covers your ears, to protect them	
gloves (n pl)			clothing that you wear on your hands to protect them or keep them warm	
protective clothing (n)			clothing that covers your body, to protect it	
safety glasses (n)			glasses that cover your eyes, to protect them	
wear (v)			to have something, e.g. clothes, shoes, glasses on your body	
incomplete (adj)			not having everything that should be there, or not completely finished	
slippery (adj)			something that is slippery is difficult to hold, walk on, etc.	
suspended (adj)			something in a high place so that it hangs down	
falling object (n)			movement down towards the ground of a solid thing that you can hold, touch or see but that is not alive	
overhead (adj)			above your head or in the sky	
trip hazard (n)			an act of falling as a result of hitting something with your foot	
fork lift truck (n)			a vehicle with special equipment on the front for lifting and moving heavy things	
guard dog (n)			a dog that is trained to guard a place	
patrol (n)			to go around the different parts of an area or building at regular times to check that there is no trouble or danger	

debris (n)			pieces of waste material	
oil (n)			a smooth thick liquid that is used to make machines run easily
